Term	Unit Title (Theme)	Description
Autumn 1	Changes in pitch, tempo and dynamics (rivers)	Exploring how music can reflect the movement and character of rivers through changes in pitch, tempo and dynamics. Developing compositional and performance skills to represent flowing water, rapids and calm stretches through sound.
Autumn 2	School performance	School Performance with Year 4
Spring 1	South and West Africa	Learning about Samba and South American musical traditions. Pupils explore rhythmic patterns, layered textures, and perform as part of an ensemble while developing understanding of musical notation to support composition and performance.
Spring 2	Indonesia Instrumental Scheme	Discovering the features of gamelan music including the Slendro scale and cyclical rhythmic patterns, identifying traditional gamelan instruments, learning about the concept of an octave, exploring how different timbres are used in gamelan music
Summer 1	Body and Tuned Percussion (Rainforests)	Exploring rainforest environments through music using body percussion and tuned instruments. Pupils develop rhythmic accuracy, layering, and dynamics to create descriptive soundscapes inspired by nature.
Summer 2	India Instrumental Scheme	Learning and understanding the history and key features of Bollywood films, how ambient sounds can be used to enhance a film score, practising staff notation and performing a film sequence using instruments and movement.
